April Show: "Spring Members Show"

May will be a Spring Members Show in the gallery which will be judged in four categories- Paintings, Photography, 3 Dimensional art and Youth in 3 grade levels. There is not a theme for this show but when planning a new piece think spring. Art, crafts and photography not shown in the gallery before will be accepted with a \$5 entry fee **for EACH piece up to 4 pieces**. If you only want to enter 1 piece it is \$5-if you enter 4 it is \$20. Youth members pay a \$5 FLAT FEE for up to 4 pieces. **Deadline for registration is April 28th. Please bring your work in on, OR before that date and fill out a registration form.** Bring in your new work and compete for prize money! Don't forget maximum size in any direction is 40". To clarify-when you have your work ready to enter for the show ready-bring it **any time before the 29th**-you will fill out the form and pay your entry fees when you bring in your work. This is a really great opportunity so don't miss it!

Spring Show Reception

An awards presentation and reception will take place for the Spring Show on May 6, 2012, it will run from 1:00 to 4:00 with awards being presented at 3:00. Light refreshments will be offered-bring yourself and a friend or neighbor-help spread the word about the Gallery!

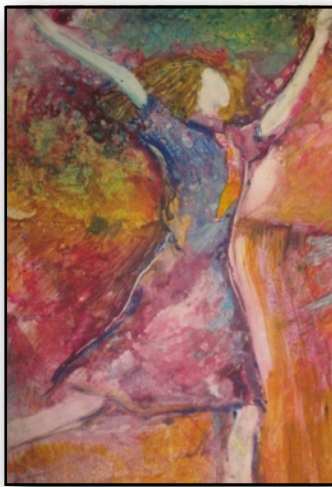
RAFFLE Tickets!
