

Entry Fees

Arts Guild members - \$10 per entry.
Non-members - \$15 per entry.
Limit - 2 entries per artist.

Awards

- Best of Show - \$250
- Up to \$2000 in additional awards.
- Winning artists will be notified by email prior to the reception date.

Eligibility

- Open to all artists age 18 and older.
- Work must be original and completed within the last two years.
- Reproductions, giclee prints, and other copies will not be accepted.
- Work shown in any previous Open Exhibit will not be accepted.

Categories for Judging

1. Oil and Acrylic Paintings
2. Watercolor Paintings
3. Other Media - includes all drawing media, pastels, encaustic, collage, mixed media, fiber and textile arts, printmaking, and others as determined by the gallery committee.
4. Three-Dimensional Art (includes all types of sculpture, ceramics, jewelry, and fine art crafts)
5. Photography and Digital Arts

All entries must be the original creation of the artist. Prints and reproductions of work will not be accepted.

Work may not be removed before April 27, with the exception of sold items removed with the permission of the Hanover Area Arts Guild. Work that is unclaimed 60 days after the closing of the exhibit will become the property of the Hanover Area Arts Guild.

Sales Agreement

Artists are encouraged, but not required, to offer entries for sale. All sales will be handled by the Hanover Area Arts Guild. The Arts Guild retains 30% of all sales, A sales check will be mailed to artists within 30 days of the close of the exhibit. Work that is not for sale must be marked "NFS" on the entry forms, with a fair-market dollar value. Entering this show indicates agreement with all terms.

Requirements

The entry form must be completed and mailed or delivered, with your check, to the Hanover Area Arts Guild, 32 Carlisle Street, Hanover, PA 17331. Entry forms must be received no later than March 17, 2018.

Art must be hand-delivered to the gallery on one of the dates listed on the back of this form. No exceptions please!

2-D art must be properly framed. Paintings and photos on stretched canvases may be unframed only if they have finished edges. All pictures must be adequately wired to hang. Other types of non-wire hangers will not be accepted.

Paintings must be dry. Watercolors, drawing media, pastels, and photographs must be framed and protected under glass or Plexiglas.

Due to space restrictions, the maximum allowable size for all work, including 3-D entries, is 32 inches in any direction. Framed work is measured from the outside edges of the frame.

Art should be appropriate for viewing by all ages. The Arts Guild reserves the right to reject any work that is deemed inappropriate, that exceeds the size limits, or is improperly framed.

Awards Judge

Rob Evans is an artist and independent curator who lives and works near Wrightsville, PA. He received a BFA from Syracuse University in 1981. His work has been featured in numerous solo and curated group exhibitions including a collection of American drawings organized by the Smithsonian Institution which toured internationally.
